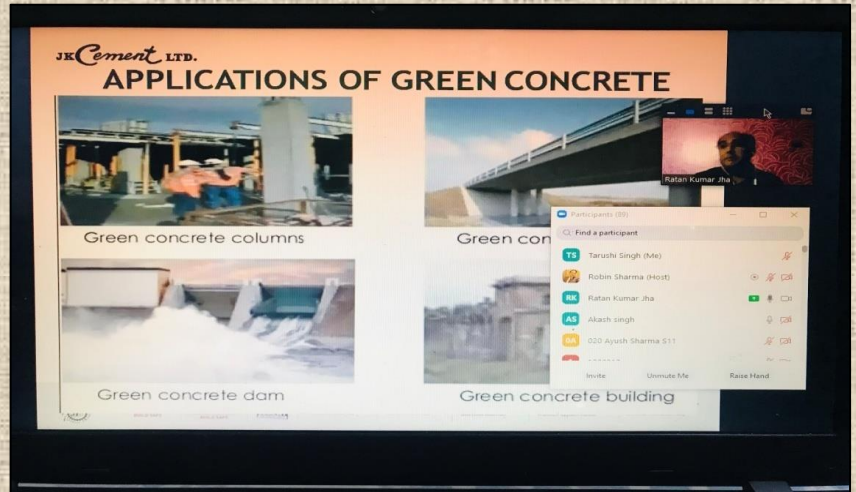
Webinar on Green Concrete

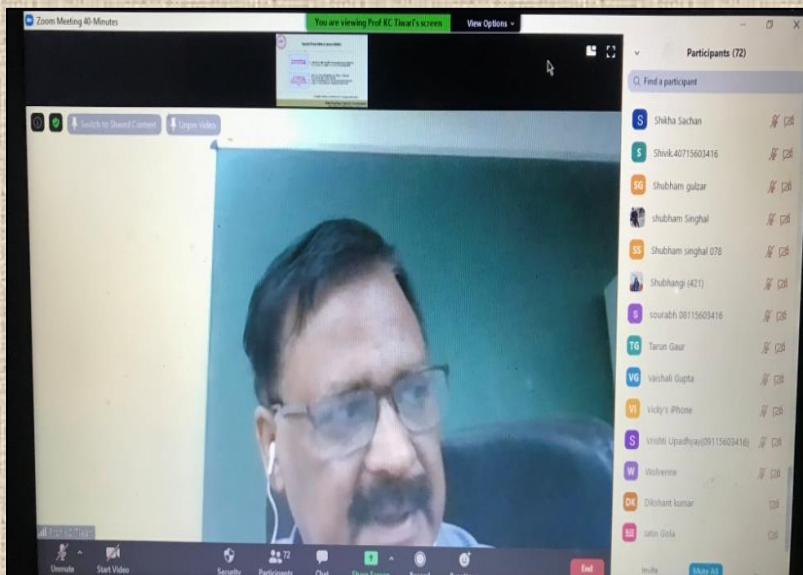

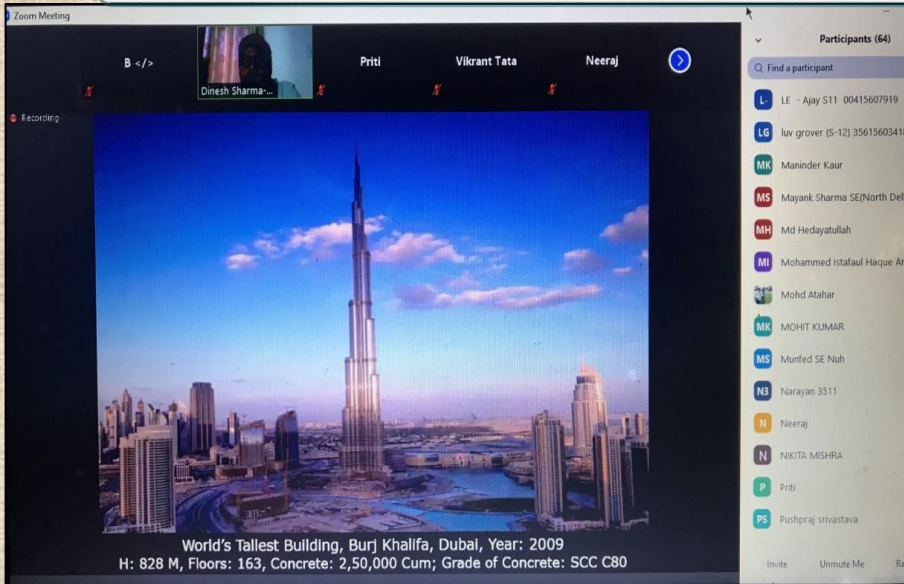
