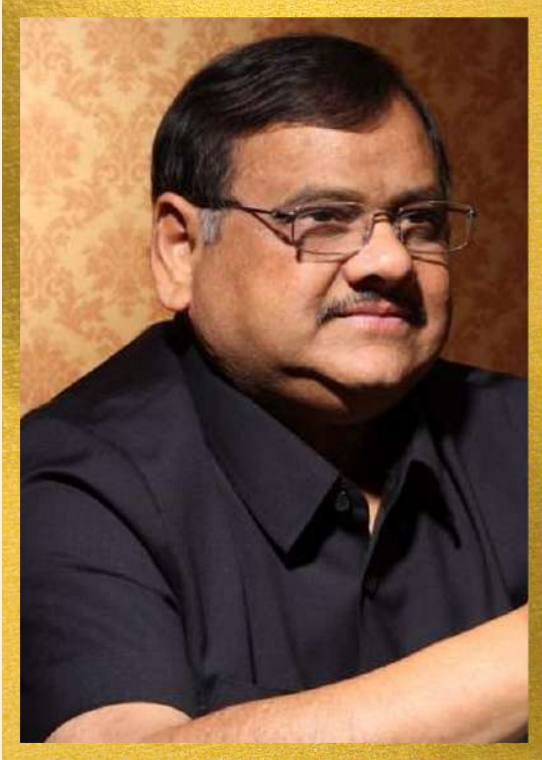

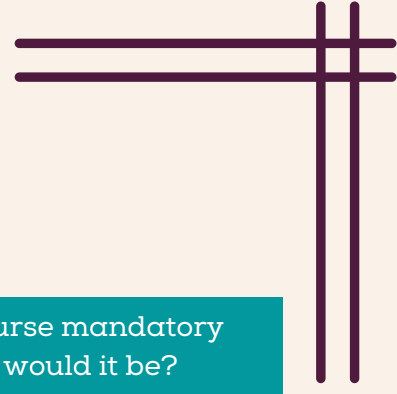
5- How has the epidemic affected your personal and professional objectives?

9- If you had to make one course mandatory for all future branches, what would it be?

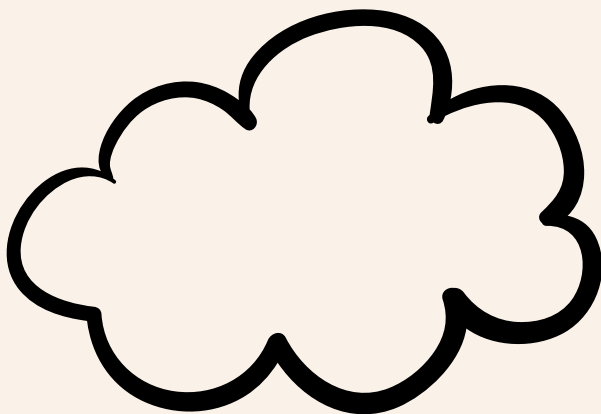
A- Mobile App Development for CS/IT branches. And Financial Planning across all branches and courses.

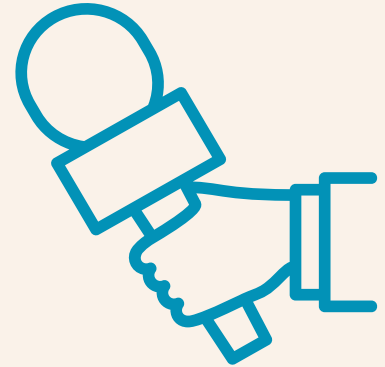

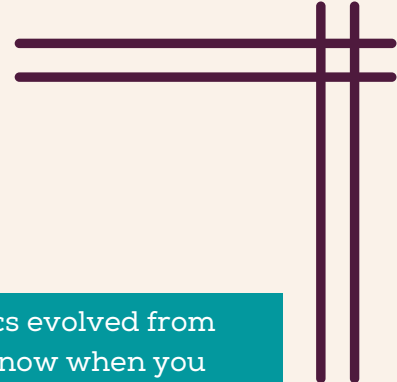
5- Has pandemic affected your life goals and work life

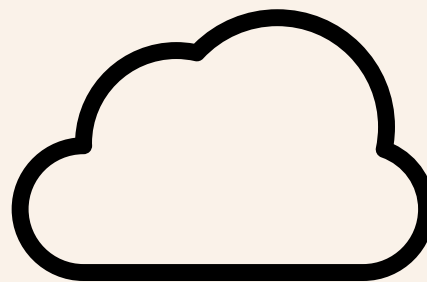
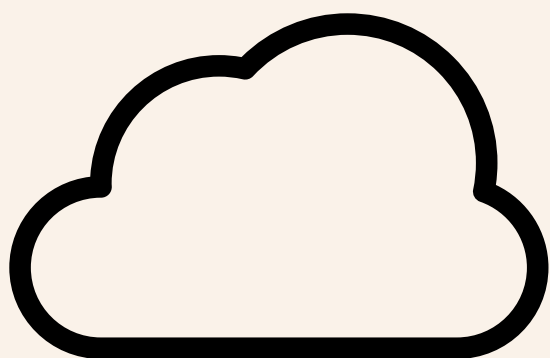

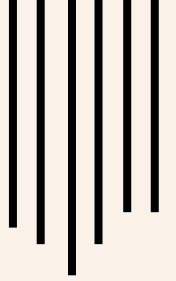
