Objectives:

The InspireHer – Campus Tour was organized to motivate **girl students** from Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Gautampuri to **pursue higher education in science and technology fields**. The visit aimed to familiarize them with **an engineering campus environment, technical laboratories, and emerging areas such as Artificial Intelligence, thereby broadening their academic and career aspirations.**

Organized By:

The event was organized by the **Department of Computer Science & Technology, ADGIPS**. Faculty members, the sports coordinator, and laboratory coordinators collaboratively planned the schedule to ensure that

the visiting students experience academic, technical, and co-curricular facets of the institute in a structured manner.

Activities:

The girl students, accompanied by their teachers, were welcomed at ADGIPS and received greetings from faculty members and the Honorable Director Sir. A separate meeting was held between the school teachers and the Director Sir, during which they were formally welcomed and presented with an honorarium as a gesture of appreciation.

Subsequently, students participated in a guided campus tour that included visits to various engineering laboratories, where coordinators explained different instruments, setups, and their practical applications. Outdoor physical activities such as running and basic fitness exercises were conducted under the guidance of the sports coordinator, followed by an insightful lecture by Mr. Mukeetuzama, faculty in the Department of Computer Science & Technology, on “Artificial Intelligence, its practical uses in daily life, and its future scope”, which concluded with an engaging puzzle round.

Through the combination of **campus exploration, lab demonstrations, physical activities, and a focused talk on Artificial Intelligence** by Mr. Mukeetuzzama, the visiting students experienced the **academic rigor, technological relevance, and supportive environment offered at ADGIPS.**

Outcomes:

The campus tour successfully enhanced the visiting students' **awareness about engineering education pathways and emerging domains like Artificial Intelligence.** Many students expressed increased interest in pursuing science and technology subjects in their higher studies **after interacting with faculty members and witnessing live demonstrations in laboratories.** The event also strengthened the **institute's community**

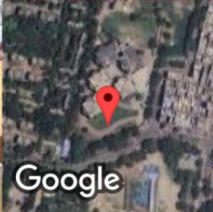
